

## Senior League Agenda 2022

- Sign-up fee this year will be \$72.00. \$45.00 will go into the prize fund and \$25.00 will cover the handicap fee. \$2.00 will be used for the Hole-in-One fund.
- The league will be a handicap league except for the senior Championship which will award low gross and loss handicap after two weeks play at the end of the year.
- Rates: League fees will be \$40.00 per round and will include the **Closest to the pin prize** each week.
- Range balls will be provided each Wednesday.
- Coffee and donuts will be provided before each round.
- Members will be able to play each Monday and Thursday for \$40.00 per round (a 4.00 per round savings)
- Four 5 week segments will be played with prize money awarded at the end of each segment.
- A formatted tournament will be worked in between each segment with prizes awarded to the first, second and third place winners.
- An end of the season gathering will be held . The event will be catered by the Restaurant staff.
- The season this year will begin on April 6th. The first three weeks will be open play to allow members without handicaps the ability to submit three scores to establish a handicap.
- The first 5 week segment will begin on April 27th.
- Play in April will commence at 8:30am and switch to 9:00am beginning May 4th.
- All league play will be as foursome to every extent possible. Hole assignments will be made before commencement of play each week.

### Rules of Play

- All play will be from the yellow tees.
- There are no mulligans allowed during league play and all putts must be holed out. There are no gimmies because this is a money league.
- Balls hit out of bounds or lost during play will be played according to a stroke and distance rule. A ball will be dropped nearest the point of going out of bounds or adjacent to where the ball is lost and a stroke taken. No ball hawking during league play and a minimal time will be pent looking for lost balls.
- Ready play will be utilized to increase the speed of play. B ready to play your ball when it is your turn to shoot.
- Balls may be rolled (fluffed) in either the fairway or rough by rolling with the club head. Touching or lifting the ball will not be permitted.

- All balls must be played from sand traps. You may moved your ball laterally to avoid standing water in the traps and a rake and place rule will be in effect. Balls may not be taken out of the traps to avoid playing from the sand.
- Relief may be taken within one club length of cart paths only if your stance is hindered.
- Relief may be taken from the 150 yard bushes **ONLY** if your swing is impaired. Then the ball may be moved within two club lengths but not on to the fairway.
- There is no such thing as a double par rule during league play. All strokes must be counted all the way into the hole.
- The #17 hole drop area will be played from the flat area immediately in front of the pond.
